1. Explain why Rani's father wants the Machis to capture the four men who escaped from jail.

- 3. On a separate sheet of paper, write a journal entry of at least two paragraphs (6-8 sentences each) reflecting on and responding to what you have read in *It's a Jungle Out There!*. Some questions you might ask yourself are "What do I think of the Machi way of life?" "What are the best and worst parts of growing up in the jungle like Rani?" "Do I agree or disagree with the way Rani or his parents handled different situations they encountered?" "Did anything make me angry, excited, confused, sad, etc.?" Especially reflect on the fact that Rani grew up leading such a foreign and even dangerous life in order for his parents to have the opportunity to translate the New Testament into the language of the Machiguenga. Where in the story do you see God's care for his servants most clearly, and would you be willing to go through what Ron Snell did in order to bring the Gospel to a people group that has never heard about God or Jesus?
