Background

Stories are written with all different types of literary devices which makes it more interesting, inviting, memorable etc. One of these devices, theme, is a common and important one. Every story has one or more themes that act as currents throughout the story. According to the All American glossary of terms, themes are "a common thread or repeated idea that is incorporated throughout a literary work.
